Ballymaloe House

Ballymaloe House is a family-run country house hotel famous for its luxurious and comfortable interiors, outstanding hospitality and superb food. This 17th century house, built on a Norman keep, is nestled in a 400-acre estate in rural East Cork, just 20 miles from the historic city of Cork, and minutes from the breathtakingly beautiful south coast. Set deep within lush countryside accessible by tree-lined avenues, the property has walled gardens, parklands, a tennis court, a small golf course and a croquet lawn. It also has its own craft and kitchenware shop.



Myrtle and Darina Allen

The original owner of Ballymaloe as it is today, Myrtle Allen, pioneered placing local, seasonal food to the fore, a philosophy now espoused by the world's top chefs. In doing so, she created the road map for Ireland's current status as a force to be reckoned with on the global culinary scene. Her daughter-in-law, Darina, Ireland's answer to Delia Smith and a household name, founded the world famous Ballymaloe cookery school nearby.

Ballymaloe Restaurant

Under head-chef Gillian Hegarty, the restaurant serves locally sourced and home grown food from the walled garden and farm and freshly caught fish from the boats at Ballycotton. The gardening team are central to the menus in the kitchen - fruit and vegetables are sent



up every morning from the gardens (*see herb garden, above*) and menus are often finalised at the last minute depending on availability. The restaurant has won many prestigious culinary awards and has had great press reviews.

Please Note

This is a sample menu and will vary according to the season and availability of produce.

Dinner will be accompanied by half a bottle of house wine per person. There will be a choice of three starters and two main courses, ordered in advance, and for dessert there will be a choice of at least five items, changing daily - you can have a bit of everything! On arrival day, dinner will be in the form of a cold buffet.

Breakfast will be a fabulous buffet selection including a cooked Irish breakfast. Lunch will be a simple but delicious two-course meal. Any dietary requirements can be catered for.

Accommodation

The 29 bedrooms are spread out over the main house and courtyard of a lime-washed, rose-covered, farm building adjacent to the main house. The rooms are all individually decorated in a simple and elegant way and all have en-suite bathrooms. Some rooms are large and airy with beautiful views over the fields; some are cosier rooms at the top of the house in the eaves; and some are newer, light-filled garden rooms at the back of the house looking towards the river and horse chestnut trees beyond.

Bedrooms come with toiletries, telephone, hairdryer, radio and cd player. The hotel does not have a lift, but there are bedrooms on the ground floor in the courtyard suitable for those with mobility difficulties including a walk-in shower. Bridge with Zeb & Claudia



Zeb Stocken has many years experience of teaching and hosting bridge events, and whether you come as a group, in a pair or on your own, you can be certain of an instructive and enjoyable game adapted to your level.

Claudia – Zeb’s sister – will be on hand to ensure the smooth running of your holiday and, as a keen and experienced bridge player herself, she will also be supervising bridge sessions. The bridge programme will be a mixture of teaching, supervised play and some duplicate – all played in a fun and friendly environment. The tuition sessions will use CompassCards (*set deals*) and a fun topic tailored to the group.

The other sessions will be supervised play or some form of duplicate, with prizes at the end of the stay. All bridge sessions are optional and open to all standards of play although we can only accommodate complete beginners if booked as a group of four. Water, tea and coffee will be available during play. Non-bridge playing partners are of course welcome.

It is important to stress that our holidays are not aimed at the type of player who likes a serious 24-board duplicate every night. Our ethos is that bridge should be a friendly and social game where you can meet like-minded people, and our holidays reflect that. No partner is needed on a StockenBridge holiday.

Excursions and things to do in the area

There will be two wonderful optional excursions and we will contact you nearer the time with details and prices to book these trips in advance:

1. Day trip to Blarney Castle and Cork

Visit Blarney Castle, kiss the magical Blarney Stone and explore the beautiful gardens. Then on for lunch in historic Cork where there are plenty of shopping possibilities including the famous 'English Market'.

2. Ballycotton

From the fishing village of Ballycotton, a boat will take you to Ballycotton Island (*right*) for a fascinating tour of the lighthouse. Then we will follow the scenic Ballycotton cliff path for an easy walk and a Ballymaloe picnic (*weather permitting*).



Golf, tennis, cycling, walking and horse-riding

There is an informal 5-hole golf course and a tennis court on the premises (*clubs/rackets and balls available*); but for the more serious golfer there is a good choice of golf courses nearby at Castlemartyr Resort, Fota Island Resort and Harbour Point Golf Club. There are many lovely walks around the Ballymaloe gardens, woodlands and farm or take one of the hotel's bicycles. Horse-riding can be booked through the Monatrea Equestrian Centre near Youghal.

Cobh and other local towns

Visit Cobh (*right*) with its cathedral and heritage centre and the last stopping port of the Titanic; the picturesque town of Kinsale and Jameson Distillery tours at Midleton.



Sea and river fishing

When the mackerel come to feed close to the shore in summer and autumn, Rory Allen takes guests out fishing on his boat from Ballycotton Pier. Fly fishing on the Blackwater River can also be organised.

Cookery demonstration

The internationally renowned Ballymaloe Cookery School is located on its own 100 acre organic farm and just two miles from Ballymaloe House. Subject to sufficient numbers (*if low numbers, guests can join the student demonstration*), we will be organising a private afternoon cookery demonstration which includes a tasting as well as a folder full of recipes.

Alternatively, try your hand at baking Irish soda bread for breakfast with the Ballymaloe bakers.



Travel Details

Cork airport is the nearest airport, with a transfer time of 45 minutes. Aer Lingus operate a number of flights per day from London Heathrow; Ryanair fly from London Gatwick and Stansted. Shannon airport, Dublin airport and Rosslare Ferry are approximately 2.5 hours' drive away.

We will include transfers from Cork airport for selected flights to fit in with checking in and out, or for a minimum of 8 guests on a flight. Otherwise airport transfers cost from 8€ - 60€ per person each way (*depending on the number of passengers*).
