The first ‘regular’ bridge break is aimed at more social bridge players while the duplicate break is aimed at confident intermediate-plus and advanced players.

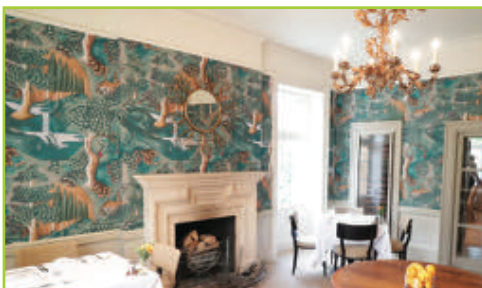


## The Cotswold House Hotel and Spa

## Food

The hotel's Fig Restaurant has an excellent reputation for food and holds two AA rosettes. The menus have been created to showcase the very best of modern British cuisine, prepared by a talented and imaginative team using seasonal ingredients from the finest local suppliers. Breakfast is a delicious array of hot and cold options including full English.

*Free range duck breast served with red cabbage, squash purée and blueberries*  
*Roasted hake with caramelised cauliflower and broccoli*

## Accommodation





Most of the 28 bedrooms are spread over three floors in the main building, though six are in the garden. They overlook the gardens or the high street and are all shapes and sizes, mainly furnished in soothing greens, browns and duck egg blue. All bedrooms have satellite televisions, free wifi and tea and coffee making facilities; some have a fireplace. En-suite bathrooms have Eco-Boutique products; some have shower-only; the others have tubs and showers in various permutations; one has a bath in the bedroom.

Please note that there is no lift but there are five ground-floor rooms suitable for the less mobile, although not fully wheelchair accessible. Please contact us for further bedroom details including accessibility and bathroom facilities. *Bedrooms are available from 3pm and check out is 11am.*

## Other things to do around and about

There are no bridge sessions scheduled for the afternoons, so this would be the perfect time to explore the local surroundings.

### The Spa at Cotswold House

At the far end of the garden, a former coach house is home to the spa with steam room and hydrotherapy pool, and offering aromatic Decl or treatments in six treatment rooms.



### Chipping Campden

Chipping Campden is one of the finest towns in the Cotswolds, full of history but plenty of life and bustle too. Visit the Court Barn Museum, the Old Silk Mill and St James' Church. There are a number of independent shops filled with antiques, art, designer brands and goods produced in the Cotswolds.



### Walking

The Cotswolds are famous for fine landscapes, gently undulating hills, picturesque villages with mellow buff stone cottages and an abundance of rivers and streams. The Cotswold Way starts in Chipping Campden, so attractive walking trails are right on the doorstep.



### Local places to visit by car

Batsford Arboretum (*15 mins away*) is a 55-acre Victorian arboretum and botanical garden and is open all year round. Visit Shakespeare's birthplace at Stratford upon Avon (*20 mins away*) or Chastleton House (*25 mins away*), a rare gem of a Jacobean country house (*right*) or the Cotswold Motoring Museum (*25 mins away*), a must for classic car enthusiasts.
