Ston Easton Park

This magnificent 18th century Palladian mansion is surrounded by 36 acres of parkland designed by Humphry Repton, a leading 18th-century landscape designer. The beautiful grounds encompass a cascading river overhung by willows and crossed by pretty bridges, and a giant walled Victorian kitchen garden.



Now a luxury 4-star hotel, Ston Easton Park is captivating: pedimented doorways, marble fireplaces, elaborate cornicing, gilt mirrors, old oil paintings, fine porcelain and antiques fill the elegant public rooms. The bedrooms are generally large, many with 4-poster beds and a stay here will take you back in time to an era of opulence, yet despite the grandeur of the house, there is a very warm welcome, making guests feel they are part of a country house party.



Fine Dining

The modern British cuisine has an excellent reputation locally with menus that use fresh, locally-sourced ingredients. The head chef works closely with local suppliers and even more closely with the hotel garden team, sourcing almost 60% of the fresh produce used in the menus from the hotel's extensive kitchen gardens. For breakfast, there is a wide selection of hot and cold options, including a full english breakfast.

Other things to do around and about

There are no bridge sessions scheduled for Wednesday afternoon, so why not explore the beautiful parkland by following the banks of the cascading River Norr? Here are some more ideas if you want to go further afield:

Cheddar Cave and Gorge (20 minutes drive away)

Visit Britain's biggest gorge, take in the dramatic cliffs rising up 450ft and explore the stunning stalactite caverns below. Created by Ice age melt-waters over millions of years, this world famous beauty spot is a National Nature Reserve and a famous site of prehistoric discoveries.

Glastonbury Abbey (30 minutes drive away)

Shrouded in mystery and legend, Glastonbury Abbey (*right*) is a fascinating ruin and a fine example of Norman architecture, dating from about 1200 and stands on one of the oldest Christian sites in Britain.



Golf (10 minutes drive away)

Farrington Park Golf and Country Club is set in a beautiful and peaceful rural location surrounded by stunning views across the former Duchy of Cornwall estate. With 27 holes of exciting and challenging golf, both the 9 and 18 hole courses offer an enjoyable and relaxing experience for all golfers.

City of Bath (30 minutes drive away)

Home to some of the nation's grandest Georgian architecture, the city of Bath was founded on top of natural hot springs and has many attractions including Bath Abbey, the Roman Bathhouses, the Royal Crescent (*below*), the Jane Austen Centre plus many more museums and sites of architectural interest.

The bridge programme will be a mixture of teaching, supervised play and some duplicate – all played in a fun and friendly environment. The tuition sessions will use CompassCards (set deals) and a fun topic tailored to the group.

All bridge sessions are optional and open to all standards of play, although we can only accommodate complete beginners if booked as a group of four. It is important to stress that our holidays are not aimed at the type of player who likes a serious 24-board duplicate every night. Our ethos is that bridge should be a friendly and social game where you can meet like-minded people, and our holidays reflect that. No partner is needed on a StockenBridge holiday.

Travel Details

Ston Easton Park is located in Somerset on the A37, 11 miles south of Bristol and Bath.

Travelling by car:

The hotel is accessible via the M4, or M3 and A303 from London. Journey time is about 2.5 hours from west London (*about 120 miles*)

Travelling by train:

Ston Easton Park is 12 miles (*30 minutes drive*) from Bath Spa train station or 14 miles from Castle Cary train station (*25 minutes drive*). There is a direct fast train to both these train stations from London Paddington. The hotel can organise a taxi pick-up and if you are happy to share with other guests travelling at the same time, let us know and we will put you in touch.
