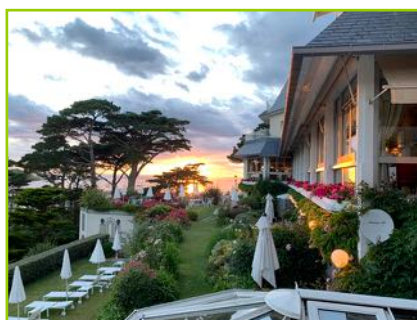

Accommodation

The 31 elegant and comfortable rooms are spread out on all floors, with either a sea or garden view. Soft fabrics, classic furnishings and a warm Breton style create a restful atmosphere, with every bedroom in a unique style. The sea-facing rooms all have a private balcony or terrace, perfect for enjoying the magnificent sunsets over the water.

All rooms have en-suite bathrooms with baths, some with showers and some both. Rooms all have television, hairdryer, slippers, dressing gowns and tea and coffee making facilities.

All bedrooms can be twinned and are accessible via two lifts which serve the whole hotel, including the pool and spa.

Bridge with Zeb & Claudia

Zeb Stocken has many years experience of teaching and hosting bridge events, and whether you come as a group, in a pair or on your own, you can be certain of an instructive and enjoyable game adapted to your level.

Claudia – Zeb's sister – will be on hand to ensure the smooth running of your holiday; Dinah, their mother, will be supervising bridge sessions as well as teaching where needed. The bridge programme will be a mixture of teaching, supervised play, teams and gentle duplicate – all played in a fun and friendly environment.

The tuition sessions will use Compass Cards (*set deals*) and a fun topic tailored to the group.



The other sessions will be supervised play or some form of duplicate or teams, with prizes at the end of the stay. All bridge sessions are optional and open to all standards of play although we can only accommodate complete beginners if booked as a group of four. We will be playing bridge in the comfortable seminar room in the main building with views out to the sea.



It is important to stress that our holidays are not aimed at the type of player who likes a serious 24-board duplicate every night. Our ethos is that bridge should be a friendly and social game where you can meet like-minded people, and our holidays reflect that.

No partner is needed on a StockenBridge holiday and non-bridge playing partners are of course welcome.

Things to do in the area

We will be organising optional excursions and will contact you nearer the time with full details. Local attractions include:

Walks

Walkers are spoilt for choice with a network of beautiful walking paths from the hotel's doorstep including spectacular cliff paths, easy beach walks dotted with interesting rock formations and gentle trails through sheltered woodland. Not forgetting the charming local port and the village of Trebeurden.



Enchanting Gardens

There are a number of exceptional gardens nearby including Jardins de Kerdalo - blending formal terraces with wild and lush landscapes. Jardin Kestellic, perched above the Trieux estuary, is packed with rare plants amongst shaded terraces, and panoramic viewpoints. The coastal Jardin de Plouhinec has colourful blooms set against the dramatic coastline, creating a striking blend of garden artistry and seaside atmosphere.



Historic Châteaux

Château de la Roche-Jagu (*right*) is a 15th-century fortress overlooking the Trieux River with panoramic terraces, and beautifully designed gardens. Nearby, the stately Château de Rosanbo traces six centuries of noble life through its refined interiors, formal French gardens, and magnificent orangerie.



Musée des Télécommunications and Planetarium de Bretagne

This museum offers a fascinating look at the evolution of communication, with hands-on exhibits, vintage technology and stories that bring the history of human connection to life. Nearby, the Planetarium de Bretagne invites visitors on an immersive journey through the stars with captivating shows, celestial storytelling, and state-of-the-art projections.

Pool, Thalgo Spa and Wellness

The hotel has a fabulous accessible indoor heated pool with panoramic views of the 'Seven Isles' archipelago, as well as a luxurious spa and wellness centre. A complete range of Thalgo and Charme d'Orient treatments are on offer for the mind, body and soul.



Travel Details

Ti Al Lannec is located in Trébeurden on the north Brittany coast.

By Car

The hotel can be reached from the UK via the Channel Tunnel or ferry into northern France. Brittany Ferries operate crossings to Roscoff (*1hr 20 min drive*), St Malo (*2hr drive*), Cherbourg, Caen and Le Havre from Plymouth, Portsmouth and Poole.

By Train

The nearest train stations are Lannion (*20-min drive*) and Plouaret-Trégor (*35-min drive*). There is a TGV train station at Rennes (*2.5hr drive*) for trains from London St Pancras taking 6 hours (*changing at Paris*)

By Air

The closest airport is Brest (*1.5hrs drive*) and Easyjet fly there from London Gatwick. However the most convenient flights are from Gatwick to Rennes (*2hrs 15 mins drive*) with Easyjet and we will be organising transfers for these flights.
